

In one of my messages, I told the story of John D. Rockefeller, Sr. He was the founder of the Standard Oil Company. He is widely considered the wealthiest American of all time. To give you some idea of his vast wealth, Jeff Bezos of Amazon is the richest man in America today and worth \$112 billion. That sounds like a lot of money, doesn't it? But by comparison, John D. Rockefeller was the richest American of all time and if his wealth was brought into today's dollars, he would be worth \$409 billion!

The great thing about John Rockefeller is that as one of the richest men in the world he was also one of the most generous. He gave away millions of dollars and there are buildings all across America with his name on them. What is interesting is that from his very first paycheck until his death he tithed on his earnings. The story is told that at one point he thought he was dying, so he began giving away his wealth. An amazing thing occurred, he lived, and he attributed his living to his having become a more generous person!
