The fall season brings lots of fun activities at school, church, and in our community. Upward is part of FBC Barnesville's Fall Season, and there are several ways that you and your family can be involved as participants, supporters, and carriers of the gospel.

Upward Sports Ministry brings opportunities to serve and engage the community by using the tool of sports and being intentional in sharing the Gospel. As ambassadors for Christ, we will have moments to share the Gospel by getting to know our community and meeting their needs. Sports ministry isn't self-serving, "just a church league," or inward-focused; it is an avenue by which we can introduce people to Christ and help them grow in a relationship with Him by connecting them to a local church. This year the participants will learn about these four key virtues during the season: Respect, Kindness, Good News, and Forgiveness. This track will introduce athletes to the important biblical concept of kindness and loving your neighbor as yourself. They'll learn that the virtues of respect, kindness, and forgiveness are essential to how God wants us to treat other people. Our key verse, Romans 12:10b (NLT), says, "Take delight in honoring each other" and (ESV) "Outdo one another in showing honor."

FBC Upward Basketball and Cheer League registration is currently open and will close November 11th. The program hosts Pre-K through 6th graders for basketball and cheer. We are praying to have a minimum of three teams in every age group for basketball and a minimum of three cheer squads. Our 3rd-6th graders must attend basketball evaluations on November 11th from 5:30-7:30p. Basketball evaluations are very important to aid the coaches in creating teams with equal basketball skills. All cheerleaders and Pre-K through 2nd grade basketball do not have evaluations. Upward practices will begin the week of December 9th, and games begin January 4th.

Volunteers are the key to having a successful Upward season. There are many ways to volunteer, from coaching basketball or cheer, becoming a referee, score keeping, giving game-day devotionals, managing concessions, and being a part of the prayer team. These are some of the many parts that help FBC have a successful Upward season. On October 27th at 6:30p, we will have an Upward volunteer meeting for anyone who is interested in volunteering this season. Since COVID, we have been actively building an Upward volunteer team who enjoys serving together. We would love to have you join us in making this season successful by sharing the Gospel, teaching the sport, and building relationships with the kids and their families.
