MISSION FOCUS



Shane and Jessica Booker New Orleans, LA

Shane and Jessica Booker planted Garden City Church in the Lower Ninth Ward of New Orleans, Louisiana, in a place of deep poverty and a general distrust of outsiders. These are big challenges the Bookers face. To overcome the sense of distrust, they want their neighbors to know they believe in and care for them. "We very much desire to disciple out of lostness and to raise up Indigenous leaders from the Lower Ninth Ward," Shane shared. "This means we must be deeply invested in the day-today lives of our neighbors so we earn the right to speak the gospel into their situations." The lack of resources was another challenge, so the Bookers employed an entrepreneurial church plant model. They started a missional coffee truck-TellTale Coffee and Creams. Shane explained, "TellTale Coffee and Creams accomplishes three goals. It provides revenue that helps to achieve missional sustainability, it helps us build relationships, and we use it often to support our community."
